Philippians 2:3-4

Humility is one of those things that can *be a little hard to put our finger on*. It is easier *to know it when we see it*, than to *describe* just what it is. You want to be confident in your abilities... but not arrogant. Humility is a *characteristic of those who follow Jesus*. (Luke 14:11) Jesus modeled humility in His own life! The ONE who is described as the **Lion** of Judah... came as the **LAMB** of God!

I would like to share two things this morning... but first, let's clear something up about humility... Humility does not mean you have to put yourself down. C.S. Lewis defined humility this way: *True humility is not thinking less of yourself; it is thinking of yourself less.*
