Acts 1:1-11 Matthew 28:16-20
Two Sermons In One!

Last week we celebrated Easter. Three days after His crucifixion, Jesus rose from the grave... **#JustAsHeSaid!** But the story of Jesus didn't end there! Acts 1:3 gives us a summary.

While the Gospels of Matthew and Mark end shortly after the resurrection, Luke and John provide additional details about what Jesus did during the time between His resurrection and His ascension into heaven. But the story of Jesus didn't end there, either!

That brings us to **#I'llBeBack!** (John 14:2-3) But the story of Jesus didn't end there, either! You could call this message **#NeverEndingStory**. The story of Jesus just *keeps* going. It goes beyond Calvary... beyond the grave... beyond His ascension... and it will go beyond His return as we fly off into eternity with Him!

Jesus told His disciples to _____. But He did not say, "*Wait for me to come back.*" He said wait for the gift the Father has promised; the Holy Spirit. Then He set into motion a series of **#WhileYouWait** instructions. With His disciples gathered around Him one more time Jesus assures them, commissions them, and comforts them.

Matthew 28:18-20 is known as the Great Commission and has long been the basis of the Christian emphasis on sharing the Gospel with the world. So, **#WhileYouWait** carry out the Great Commission.
